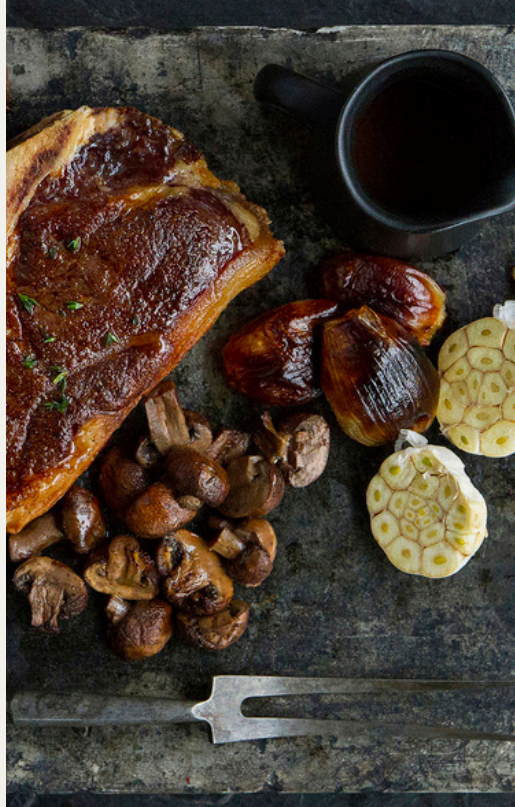

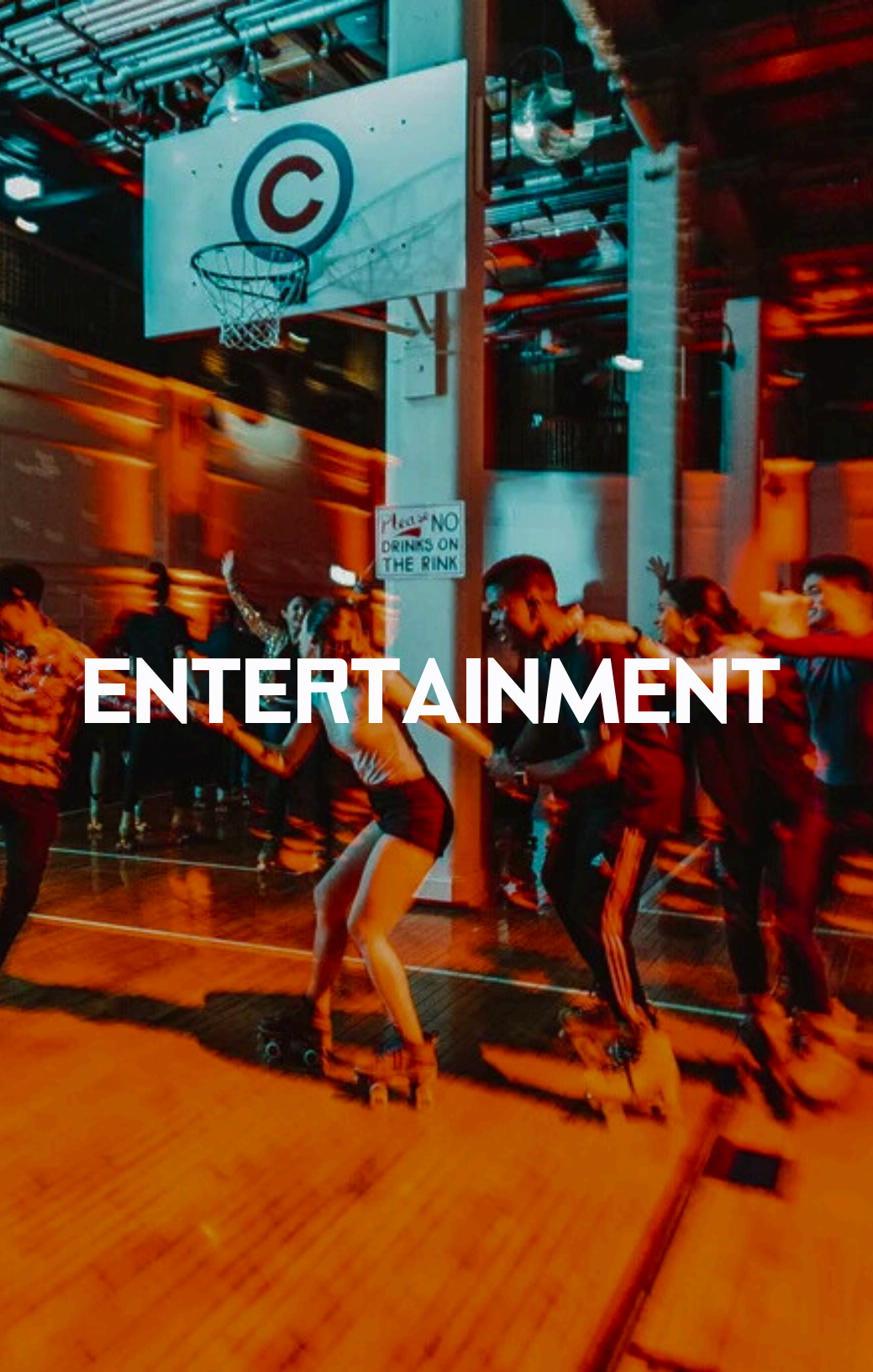

BUDDY GUY'S LEGENDS

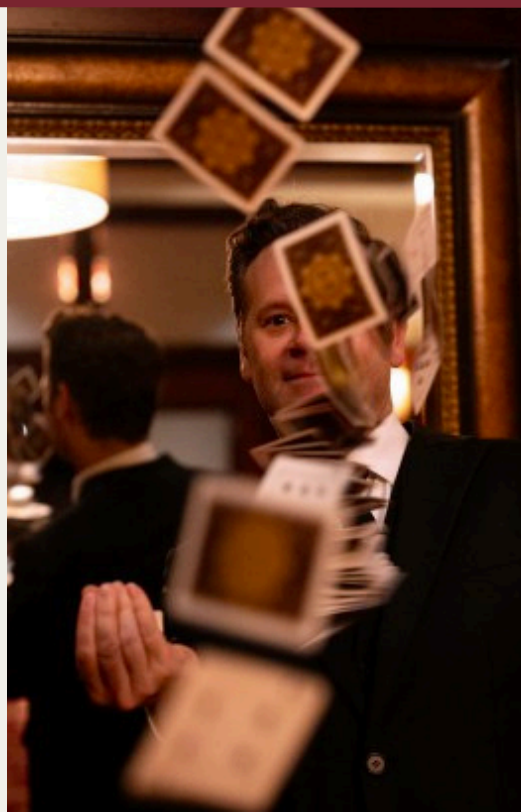

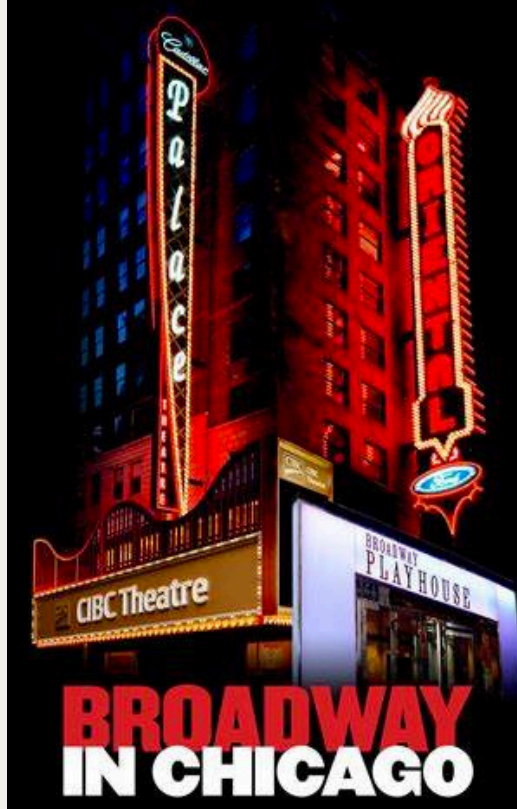
